* As per approved guidelines of EIACP the expenditure towards travel shall be limited to ₹2 lakh per annum.

2. The grant will be regulated in accordance with the instructions of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. The Grants-in-Aid are also subject to the General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated, thereunder, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions:-

- (i) Payments towards wages/remuneration as well as other contractual obligations shall be made through bank accounts of recipients under DBT scheme.
- (ii) The EIACP PC-RP shall submit evidence of deposit of TDS/Service Tax/GST and copy of PF & ESI contributions of employees, wherever applicable, in case of contract payments and CST in case of purchase of leviable goods.
- (iii) The EIACP PC-RP will furnish the Utilization Certificate, Expenditure Statement, and progress report of physical deliverables along with photographs for the F.Y. 2023-24 for uploading on the website of the Ministry for public access.
- (vi) A separate bank account shall be maintained for the purpose and the account of EIACP PC-Hub at **DESKU, Nadia** shall be open for audit by C&AG or by any person authorized by him on his behalf in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC 1971) as amended from time to time and shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority whenever it is called upon to do so.
- (v) The expenditure should not exceed beyond the approved allocation of funds.
- (vi) The relevant provision of GFR-2017 to be followed.
- (vii) There should not be any overlapping of activities under the programme with activities of any other on-going programme/scheme of Central/State Government.
- (viii) Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grants shall not be disposed off without obtaining prior approval of the Ministry.
- (ix) The EIACP PC-RP at **DESKU, Nadia** shall furnish performance-cum-achievement report within prescribed time limit for uploading on the website of the Ministry for public access.
- (x) The EIACP PC-RP will spend Grants-in-Aid exclusively in pursuance of the objectives envisaged and as per terms and conditions and agreement signed by the Ministry and EIACP PC-RP at **DESKU, Nadia**.
- (xi) The EIACP PC-RP would utilize the grant for the purpose for which it is sanctioned.
- (xii) The EIACP PC-RP is advised to adopt corruption mitigation strategies while utilizing the funds.
- (xiii) Grants-in-Aid to EIACP PC-RP at **DESKU, Nadia** is subject to the Economy Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- (xiv) Grants-in-Aid shall be utilized before the end of the current financial year 2023-24 and unspent balance, if any, will be refunded by the EIACP PC-RP to the Govt. of India with interest.
- (xv) Noted in Grants-in-Aid Register and Expenditure Control Register **Sl.No.17**.

3. The expenditure involved will be met from within the Sanctioned Budget Grant-in-aid under Demand No.28, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Major Head 3435- Ecology & Environment, 3435.03.102.09.03 – Environmental Information Awareness Capacity Building and Livelihood Programme, 31 - Grant-in-aid (General) for the financial year 2023-24.

4. The grantee organisation falls in the category of “Statutory Bodies”.


